

cause. Reference is hereby made to said verdict which is hereby incorporated by reference.

As part of its verdict, the jury attributed responsibility for the harm for which recovery was sought as follows:

a.	Robert William Baldwin	0 percent
b.	City of Dallas	45 percent
c.	H.N.T.B.	45 percent
d.	Kasler Corporation	10 percent
e.	Cecil Smith	<u>0 percent</u>
	TOTAL	100 percent

The Court further finds that the jury awarded Plaintiff Cecil Smith, Individually, against Defendants City of Dallas and H.N.T.B., jointly and severally, the amount of Seventeen Million, Eight Hundred Seventy Two Thousand, One Hundred Seventy Six Dollars and 92/100 (\$17,872,176.92) in actual damages.

The Court further finds that the jury awarded Plaintiff Jacquelyn R. Smith damages against Defendants City of Dallas and H.N.T.B., jointly and severally, the amount of One Million, One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,150,000) in actual damages.

The Court further finds that Plaintiffs Jennifer Lynn Smith, Stacey Ernestine Hart, Lori Denise Camp, Patricia Diana Rhodes, and Daniel Wayne Smith, were each individually awarded against Defendants City of Dallas and H.N.T.B., jointly and severally, the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) per Plaintiff.

The Court further finds that Plaintiff Cecil Wayne Smith was awarded exemplary damages against Defendant H.N.T.B. for their grossly negligent conduct in the amount of Twenty Two Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars and 24/100 (\$22,500,000.24).

It appearing to the Court that the verdict of the Jury is for Plaintiffs Cecil Wayne Smith, Jacquelyn R. Smith, Jennifer Lynn Smith, Stacey Ernestine Hart, Lori Denise Camp, Patricia Diana Rhodes and Daniel Wayne Smith, and against Defendants the City of Dallas and H.N.T.B. and it further appearing to the Court that Plaintiffs agreed to a judgment non obstante veredicto with respect to the jury's findings on punitive damages and gross negligence and agreed to an order dismissing all claims against Defendant, H.N.T.B. in this case with prejudice, judgment should be rendered on the verdict in favor of Plaintiffs and against the Defendant the City of Dallas, pursuant to the Texas Civil Remedies Code Section 101.023 in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars and no/100 (\$250,000.00).

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that Plaintiff Cecil Wayne Smith have and recover actual damages from the City of Dallas in the sum of Two Hundred Twenty Eight Thousand, Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars and no/100 (\$228,850.00) representing a proportionate percentage of the \$250,000 in accordance with the Jury's verdict of Seventeen Million, Eight Hundred Sixty Two

Thousand, One Hundred Seventy Six Dollars and 92/100
(\$17,862,176.92).

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that Jacquelyn R. Smith have and recover actual damages from the City of Dallas in the sum of Fourteen Thousand, Seven Hundred and Seventy Five Dollars (\$14,775.00) representing a proportionate percentage of the \$250,000 in accordance with the Jury's verdict of One Million, One Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$1,150,000).

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that Plaintiffs Jennifer Lynn Smith, Stacey Ernestine Hart, Lori Denise Camp, Patricia Diana Rhodes, and Daniel Wayne Smith, each individually recover damages from Defendant City of Dallas the sum of One Thousand, Two Hundred Seventy Five and no/100 (\$1,275.00) each, a proportionate percentage of the \$250,000 in accordance with the jury's verdict of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) per Plaintiff.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the judgment hereby rendered shall bear interest at the rate of 10 percent from the date of judgment until paid.


All costs and court expense incurred in this cause are hereby judged against Defendant City of Dallas. All writs and processes
